- To allow for live video comments, the Meeting Organizer will bring you into the meeting as a panelist. As you are brought in, Zoom will reload on your device this may take a moment. Speakers will be queued up several at a time
- Please wait until the Meeting Organizer calls on you to speak. When it is your turn to speak, the Meeting Organizer will invite you to turn your video and microphone on so that you may address the Commission. You will be asked to raise your hand if you are called to speak.

Sample Public Comment

It is important that your public comment includes your name, the community you live/work in, and articulates your support for the Mayor's proposal which adds 200 additional Safe Parking spaces at H Barracks. Here is some sample language:
