2404 Loring Street: #199051 Sprint/Clearwire is proposing a total of eight (8) panel antennas and three (3) directional antennas (microwave dishes) on an existing residential retirement complex (Wesley Palms), and a new equipment cabinet next to the existing cabinets within the existing enclosure on site. The existing Sprint facility currently contains six (6) panel antennas, which was permitted under Conditional Use Permit No. 99-0271-33. The property is located in the RS-1-4 Zone.
