Presenter: Kim Grant. Architect **Description:** Process 2 Coastal Development Permit for demolition of an existing duplex and the construction of a new 3795 square foot, three story residence with an ADU, basement, terraces and balcony. The 0.11 acre site is in the RM-1-1 Zone, parking impact zone, transit priority area and residential tandem parking overlay zone.
