Presenter: Robert Bateman of San Diego Land Surveying **Description:** Process 4 Condo Conversion Tentative Map to convert eight residential units in two buildings that are currently under construction in the RM-2-5 Zone. The underlying development permit was approved by PBPG 14-0 in October of 2019. The Subcommittee reviewed at the September 2 meeting and recommended approval.
