- * The agenda is posted on the website three (3) days in advance of the each subcommittee meeting. On the website, click the "subcommittees" link, then click the "Commercial/Residential/Mixed Use Subcommittee" link.
- * Applicants must contact the subcommittee chair at least ten (10) days in advance of a scheduled subcommittee meeting to request placement of the project for review on the agenda. The subcommittee chair for 2017 is Karl Rand (karlrand22@gmail.com)
- * The Applicant must present the project for review at a subcommittee meeting before the applicant can make a presentation to the full PBPG board at a General Meeting.

The following items must be provided to the subcommittee chair at least seven (7) days in advance of the scheduled subcommittee meeting. Submittals are <u>preferred in pdf format via e-mail attachments</u>. Required documents include the following:

- 1. The current cycle issues report from the City of San Diego. Most issues must be cleared.
- 2. The current assessment letter from the City of San Diego.
- 3. A completed Climate Action Plan Consistency Checklist.
- 4. A full set of architectural plans. Applicants should also bring one full set (up-to-date version) of hard copy paper plans as a backup in the event of projector technical problems.
- 5. A Copy of the Community Planning Committee Distribution Form Part 2 properly filled out.
- 6. Project renderings are strongly encouraged but not required. The planning group prefers to see color renderings of the final project, including landscaping design.
- 7. Applicants are asked to complete the <u>Residential Project Design Checklist for Pacific Beach EcoDistrict Compatibility.</u>
