

## Pacific Beach Planning Group Project Prioritization

On September 20, the following 22 Capital improvement Projects (CIP) for Pacific Beach will be presented on posters. Every community member will have 11 votes to use to indicate which projects they think have the highest priority for the community. People can use all 11 of their votes on one project, or may spread their votes on different projects.

NOTE: If a project has **FUNDED THIS YEAR** after the title, this means that funding in this year's city budget has been confirmed since the last Planning Group meeting, and you should not vote for it.

The titles of the CIP projects are listed below, grouped by theme (If relevant).

### Bikes

1. Install bike lanes from Campland entrance, along Pacific Beach Dr. to Crown Point Dr., then south on Crown Point Dr. to Crown Point Shores Park entrance at Lamont St.
2. Study restriping Garnet Ave. between Balboa Ave. and Ingraham St. to add bike lanes in both directions.

### Miscellaneous

3. Realign Pacific Beach Dr. at Olney St. and make drainage improvements between Olney St. and Campland entrance.
4. Build North Pacific Beach Lifeguard Tower.
5. Install streetlights on Rose Creek Trail.
6. Repair seawall from South Mission Beach to Crystal Pier. **FUNDED THIS YEAR**

### Pedestrian

7. Install sidewalks on the south side of Bluffside Ave. and along southbound Mission Bay Dr. starting at Bluffside Ave. to Garnet Ave.
8. Install a crosswalk with pedestrian beacons, a pedestrian refuge island, and curb extensions at Soledad Rd. at Los Altos Way.
9. Install pedestrian beacons on Ingraham St. at Fortuna Ave.
10. Install continental cross-walks or beacons on Garnet Ave. where it intersects with Kendall St.
11. Install continental cross-walks or beacons on Garnet Ave. where it intersects with Morrell St.
12. Install continental cross-walks or beacons on Garnet Ave. where it intersects with Noyes St.
13. Install continental cross-walks or beacons on Garnet Ave. where it intersects with Pendleton St.
14. Repair and improve entire length of Garnet Ave. sidewalks on both sides.

### Signs

15. Install Pacific Beach "entrance sign" at westbound Balboa Ave.
16. Install Pacific Beach "entrance sign" northbound at the Ingraham St. bridge.
17. Install Pacific Beach "entrance sign" southbound on La Jolla Blvd.
18. Install Pacific Beach "entrance sign" at northbound Mission Blvd. after the I-5 off-ramp.

### **Traffic flow**

19. Install traffic circle on Foothill Blvd. at Vickie Dr.
20. Study making Crown Point Dr. between Pacific Beach Dr. and Lamont St. one way.
21. Install traffic regulating measures on Beryl St. between Foothill Blvd. and Soledad Mountain Rd. and on Lamont St. between Diamond St. and Kate Sessions Park.
22. Reconfigure Grand Ave. / Mission Bay Dr. intersection per Balboa Ave. Trolley Station Plan.

In addition, the Planning Group would like to get the community's view on the priorities of projects in two other categories: Street Repaving and the Installation of new four-way stop signs.

Like with the CIP projects, the following projects will be presented on posters and people will have additional votes to use to indicate which projects in each category should have the highest priority.

### **Street repaving (people will have two votes to use for these projects)**

1. Repave Mission Blvd. from Loring St. to Chalcedony St. **FUNDED THIS YEAR**
2. Repave Grand Ave. from Rose Creek to Mission Bay Dr.
3. Repave Ingraham St. from Riviera Dr. to La Playa Ave.
4. Repave Riviera Dr. between Ingraham St and Moorland Dr.
5. Repave worst 5% of streets in Pacific Beach per the latest city survey which began March 2023.
6. Repave Soledad Rd north of Loring St. **FUNDED THIS YEAR**

### **4-way stop signs. (people will have two votes to use for these projects)**

1. Install 4-way stop signs at the intersection of: Emerald St. & Fanuel St.
2. Install 4-way stop signs at the intersection of: Emerald St. & Dawes St.
3. Install 4-way stop signs at the intersection of: Emerald St. & Bayard St,
4. Install 4-way stop signs at the intersection of: Hornblend St. & Fanuel St.
5. Install 4-way stop signs at the intersection of: Hornblend St. and Cass St. Save the document
