 - c. DC: Ask Chris Olson? Beautiful PB
- 10. Request city correct street corner at SE of Dawes and Tourmaline (Action)
 - a. Bring into standard conformance and remove the protrusion of the curb. 5-0-0
- 11. Pacific Promenade alley update Don Gross
 - a. Better; fences down. But now parking in the alley, saying permit only. Dumpsters in alley. Since it's a dirt alley, and not improved, code compliance can't intervene.
